Authors are requested to submit manuscripts in two hard copies with a set of original maps/illustrations and a soft copy on CD on MS word file and all illustrations (diagrams, maps, photoplates etc.) in .tif file format. We send each manuscript to at least two reviewers. Mailing costs being prohibitive, the articles will not be returned to authors.

Manuscripts should preferably not exceed ten printed pages or between 3000-4000 words. They should be typed double-spaced on quarto paper (21x28 cm) with wide margins. The manuscript should contain a title page, an abstract, the list of references cited, tables, a list of figures and captions. Authors sending their figures on CD should provide each figure separately in tiff format.

The letter accompanying the manuscript should contain a statement confirming that neither the whole article nor any substantial portion of it has been published elsewhere. If you have any questions or require more detailed guidelines for authors, e-mail: surajog@hotmail.com.
